

## 2015 PRIMAL SURF & PADDLEBOARD LESSONS INFO

- **Scheduling Lessons:** you can schedule daily through August 31<sup>st.</sup>, you can book one day at a time, as many as you need until you are satisfied with your ability to catch and ride waves, or paddleboard in all conditions.
- **Ages 6 & Up For Surfing / 10 & Up For Paddleboard:** private and semi private lessons are required for younger or special needs students.
- **Keep the Board and Suit for the rest of the day;** extra \$15 for surfboard & wetsuit and \$30 for paddleboard, paddle, & pfd; return it by 5:00. \*\*Please leave the sand at the beach!
- **The Areas Best Surf School Beach:** We have the absolute best beaches for learning how to surf and paddleboard! Brigantine is actually part of a wildlife refuge. The water is clean, and the scenery is great!
- **Our Equipment:** We always have new top of the line equipment, and provide wetsuits with surf lessons.
- **Conditions:** we check the beaches early for the best teaching location. Be sure to have your cell phone on and close by so you don't miss an early update of time, location change, or cancellation due to weather conditions. If you do not receive a call or text, then your lesson will be at Location 1. Be sure to put your **correct cell phone #** on the sign up form.
- **Location 1 Address:** Park near Pepper Cove & Ocean Dr. West. Take the stairs over the bulkhead to the beach. Look for the Primal Surf Vehicle and surf gear trailer on the beach.
  - This beach is a great place to hang out for the day. The gentle waves are great for beginner and novice surfers.
- **Location 2 Address:** Park on the street at 38<sup>th</sup> St. & Ocean Ave. Walk down the gravel path to the beach. Look for the Primal Surf white Suburban and surf gear trailer on the beach.
  - This is also a beautiful beach, and is used as an alternate location when needed.
- **Sunscreen:** use it sparingly and apply it early if needed. Wash it off your hands so they're not slippery. Getting sunscreen on the surf gear can make things challenging.
- **Rash Guards & UV Protectant Tops:** are great to wear to protect you from rashes and sunrays.
- **What To Bring:** Bring a towel, water bottle, and hoodie for cloudy days.
  - **Do Not Drive Vehicles on The Beach:** without proper Brigantine Beach 4wd permit. They can be purchased for \$175 at Beach Fee Office, located at 265 42nd Street.
